

# WIKA Kazakhstan opens new factory in Atyrau

On 1 November 2023, the WIKA production site in Atyrau officially started operation. On this occasion, WIKA invited business partners to attend a grand opening ceremony.

## Inauguration of the new building

WIKA built a new site in Atyrau, Kazakhstan, to be able to meet the growing demand in the Central Asian and Caucasian region. The project team designed, assembled, and commissioned the production lines within six months only, thus achieving one of fastest project delivery times in the WIKA history.

On 1 November 2023, Andreas Keiger, EVP Sales EMEAI, performed the official ceremony together with Enver Shulgin, SVP CIS region. In addition to the staff, around one hundred customers, business partners and representatives of authorities took part in the inauguration and ribbon cutting. Afterwards the guests had the opportunity to visit the new building. In the afternoon, the group moved to the Oil & Gas university in Atyrau, where welcome speeches by officials and business partners were given. WIKA's top management presented the company's global and regional strategy including its product and service offering. The evening closed with a get-together and dinner.

### Long-term goals and local partnerships

"This new venture in Atyrau is more than just an expansion of our global footprint. Our primary objective for this establishment is to meet the growing demand in Central Asian nations such as Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Tajikistan, Mongolia, and Azerbaijan. The factory's location will also enhance our export capabilities, further reinforcing our commitment to collaborating with local suppliers and manufacturers. This, in turn, will boost local production and substantially reduce logistics costs. Our facility will set the standard for local production of measuring instruments," says Andreas Keiger.

## **Education and sustainable development**

"Additionally, we will partner with the Oil & Gas university in Atyrau to combine theoretical knowledge with practical education. Students will learn about real production processes and best practices in metrology. They will experience the working environment in an international company with promising career perspectives and



personal growth opportunities. WIKA's company policy is focused on sustainable development and a local footprint," states Enver Shulgin.

The Atyrau site will produce and deliver pressure gauges, diaphragm seals and electronic temperature measuring instruments. All products will be tested and verified in a high-end calibration laboratory to meet highest customer requirements. The main segments served will be the oil & gas, energy, chemical, petrochemical and mining industries of the region. With the launch of production today, WIKA is taking a first step in Atyrau but already has plans to develop and increase production over the next years in Kazakhstan.
